	In pursuit of this, Brunei Darussalam adheres to the following guiding principles:
	 Mutual respect for the territorial integrity, sovereignty, independence and national identity of all nations; Recognising the equality of all nations large and small; Adhering to the principle of non-interference in the internal affairs of other nations; Advocating peaceful settlement of disputes; Cooperation for mutual benefit.
	Brunei Darussalam carries out its foreign policy through bilateral and multilateral cooperation on the basis of friendship, mutual respect and peaceful co-existence. This is implemented through:
	 Establishing diplomatic relations with all friendly nations; Promoting and strengthening bilateral and multilateral cooperation in various fields through the country!

- by fostering deeper understanding among countries;
