IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ASEAN OUTLOOK ON THE INDO-PACIFIC 5-6 September 2023

The ASEAN Indo-Pacific Forum (AIPF): Implementation of the ASEAN Outlook on the Indo-Pacific, is a flagship event organized by Indonesia as part of its ASEAN Chairmanship in 2023.

This inaugural forum aims to unlock further opportunities and build stronger connectivity between ASEAN countries and the Indo-Pacific. It will be held at the Mulia Hotel, Jakarta on 5-6 September 2023, in parallel with the 43rd ASEAN Summit and Fast Asia Summit

ASEAN is home to some of the world's fastest-growing economies, with a growing market and productive population. The Indo-Pacific accounts for over 60% of global GDP and around half of global trade and serves as a significant economic hub fostering trade, investment, and innovation. Located in the heart of the Indo-Pacific, ASEAN is poised to become a center of economic activity in the coming decades – in line with the ASEAN 2023 theme of ASEAN Matters: Epicentrum of Growth.

The Forum will serve as an inclusive platform for ASEAN member states and partners, from the public and private sectors, to engage in constructive discussions, identify potential tangible projects, and promote collaboration in the Indo-Pacific. It will bring together government and private sector leaders, representatives from international financial institutions (IFIs) and international organizations.

Three major issues of the future of common concern, namely green infrastructure and resilient supply chains, digital transformation and creative economy, and sustainable and innovative financing, will take center stage in the discussions and project showcases.

A number of opportunities are offered to the business community, including: • First-hand insights from heads of state and business leaders from across the region on the current global situation, as well as future economic cooperation between ASEAN and countries in the Indo-Pacific. • Collaboration, networking and business matchmaking opportunities with like-minded and results-oriented businesses and stakeholders from

 Presentations on potential and strategic projects that will shape ASEAN and the Indo-Pacific in the years to come.

The forum is a critical opportunity for ASEAN and the Indo-Pacific to come together and chart a course for collaboration and growth. Businesses must engage more proactively in ASEAN to succeed in this dynamic region.
